ARRIVING BY CAR

From the M42 Motorway

Leave the M42 at junction 3 (A435) and follow the signs to Birmingham.
At the first island take the 2nd exit and continue along the dual carriageway (A435).

At the next island, the dual carriageways ends but continue on the A435 (2nd exit) following the signs.

You will pass through a small parade of shops and continue down this road, Alcester Road South. At the next set of traffic lights go straight over and you will drive through Kings Heath High Street.

As the High St. comes to an end you will approach a set of traffic lights. Go in the right hand lane and follow the road round to the right, up a slight hill. You are now entering Moseley. Follow the road round and you will arrive in Moseley Village. As the houses end and the shops begin there is a pay and display car park on your right (next to Kingfisher take away).

The Post Office Building is almost opposite this car park.

From the M6, Junction 6

Follow A38(M) to the City Centre

After 2 miles the road becomes elevated, and at the end of this piece of road the Queensway tunnel begins. Pass under the first segment, the second and the third, and when the tunnel ends you will find yourself on Bristol Street.

Continue straight on, through the traffic lights where you will see a McDonalds on your right and Bellevue Health Clinic on your left. You are now on the Bristol Road. Continue straight on for approx 1.5 miles.

At the next traffic light junction turn left, this is now Edgbaston Road. You will pass the Edgbaston Cricket Ground on your left just before arriving at a roundabout. Take the 2nd exit to Moseley Village (Salisbury Road). Follow the road to the traffic light crossroads, and turn right.

There is a pay and display car park immediately on your left (just after the Kingfisher take away). The Post Office Building is almost opposite this car park

ARRIVING BY TRAIN

From New Street Station

From the Station you can either take a taxi which will cost approximately £6 or a bus straight to Moseley Village which will take around 15 mins.

Buses from town: 50, 35

For all buses, leave the station by the escalators in the main station building (next to Burger King). You are now in The Pallasades, at the top of the escalators turn left and follow the path round the to exit (Woolworths, Holland & Barrett). Follow the ramp down into the centre of the shopping area, New Street.

For the 50: At this point turn right and walk down New Street at the end turn left and you will see Marks & Spencer on the right a bit further down. The 50 leaves from behind Marks & Spencer. You will need to alight from the bus in Moseley Village, by the Kingfisher take away, and the Post Office Building is nearly opposite.
